Open Burning Permit Application

OAC 1301:7-7-02 (B)(202) - “Open Burning” - The burning of materials wherein products of combustion are emitted directly into the ambient air without passing through a stack or chimney from an enclosed chamber. Open burning does not include road flares, smudge pots and similar devices associated with safety or occupational uses typically considered open flames, recreational fires or use of portable outdoor fireplaces.

OAC 1301:7-7-03 (G)(307.2) - A permit is required to be obtained from the fire code official in accordance with rule 1301:7-7-01 of the OAC prior to kindling a fire for recognized silviculture or range or wildlife management practices, prevention or control of disease or pests, or a bonfire. Application for such approval shall only be presented by, and permits issued to the owner of the land upon which the fire is to be kindled.

OAC 1301:7-7-03 (G)(307.2.1) - Where required by state or local law or regulations, open burning shall only be permitted with prior approval from the state or local air and water quality management authority (Ohio EPA), provided that all conditions specified in the authorization are followed.
